COMPLETED RENOVATION

Four years ago, we set out on an ambitious renovation program to refurbish The House. We are about 80% complete having accomplished these long overdue repairs.

Windows. 45 new energy efficient Pella windows were made possible by a generous discount from distributor **Ron Hauf '82**.

Brick & Mortar Repair. Buildings and wall have been all tuck pointed.

New Front Entry Porch. The granite steps were reset and a new tile floor was installed to match the original thanks to a generous donation by **Jim Murphy '51** in memory of his mother who was also the last Beta Delta Housemother.

Parking Lot. The old concrete was removed and replaced with heavy duty rebar enforced concrete that included six new parking spots. All was made possible by a generous donation by **JC McLaughlin '74**

Kitchen & Breakfast Nook Renovation. New paint, new flooring and new shutters.

Furniture. Main deck is now graced with all new leather furniture, tables and lamps.

Music Room Renovation. New wall paper, refinished grand piano and historic document installation thanks to the efforts of **Joe Ford '71, Bob Rowe '80** and **John Rimel '79**.

Fire & Building Safety. Boiler Room is now encased in fire wall and asbestos wrapped pipes remediated thanks to efforts of **Mark Peterson '76**.

Dining Room. New furniture and dishes were installed, lighting repaired and walls and cleaned thanks to **Jim Lee '59, Don Oliver '58, Bill Todd '57** and **Ron Lundquist '57** in memory of **Bob Palin '58**.

Sun Deck. New membrane surface.

Tile Roof. Four years in process, both The House and Garage sport new tile

roofs along with copper flashing and gutters.

Fire Escape Upgrade. The rear fire escape has been reconfigured and upgraded for safety and fit with the new roof.

STILL TO DO

Even though much has been accomplished over the past three years, there is much still to do. We are preparing for a Gala Centennial Celebration in 2006. Here is our Yet To Do List:

Bedrooms Refurbish with wall and trim repair, paint, light fixtures, new carpet and window treatments.

2nd & 3rd Floor Hallways Refurbish with wall repair, paint and carpet.

Slant Shack & Back Shack Insulate walls and install energy efficient wall heaters; install fire wall on garage side; rebuild stairs to Slant.

Ski Shack Repair cracked foundation, brick and mortar; install new roof and gutters.

Fireplaces Repair crumbled firebrick and floor tile; repair copper hoods; install custom fit doors/screens.

Window Treatments 1st Floor Install new draperies and/or blinds.

Archive Storage Room Refurbish to allow better storage, temperature and moisture control.

Library Renovation Refinish walls and floor; repair stain glass windows; repair lighting.

Landscaping. Develop new landscape design. Remove overgrown or dead trees, bushes and plants. Install sprinkler system. Install new landscaping according to plan.

The goal is to have all work completed for Beta Delta's 100th Anniversary in 2006. As you can see, there is still much to do but we will continue as long as financial support continues.

FUNDRAISER AT \$276,974

Our capital fundraiser is almost 80% “there” with 274 brothers contributing. For the names, see the back of the Give Back Fundraiser Form.
