COMPLETED RENOVATION

Five years ago, we set out on an ambitious renovation program to refurbish The House. We are about 85% complete having accomplished these long overdue repairs.

Fire Safety. This past winter, major upgrades were accomplished by installing a new smoke detection system throughout the House. The Fire Marshall has become more aggressive in the requirements for Siberia so Class Room and FUBAR no longer may have locked doors.

Upgraded Heating & Electrical. Back Shack and Slant Shack received long overdue upgrades

WORK STILL TO DO

Even though much has been accomplished over the past three years, there is much still to do. We are preparing for a Gala Centennial Celebration in 2006. Here is our Yet To Do List:

Bedrooms Refurbish with wall and trim repair, paint, light fixtures, new carpet and window treatments.

2nd & 3rd Floor Hallways Refurbish with wall repair, paint and carpet.

Slant Shack & Back Shack Insulate walls and install energy efficient wall heaters; install fire wall on garage side; rebuild stairs to Slant.

Ski Shack Repair cracked foundation, brick and mortar; install new roof and gutters.

Fireplaces Repair crumbled firebrick and floor tile; repair copper hoods; install custom fit doors/screens.

Window Treatments 1st Floor
Install new draperies and/or blinds.

Archive Storage Room Refurbish to allow better storage, temperature and moisture control.

Library Renovation Refinish walls and floor; repair stain glass windows; repair lighting.

Landscaping Develop new landscape design. Remove overgrown or dead trees, bushes and plants. Install sprinkler system. Install new landscaping according to plan.

The goal is to have all work completed for Beta Delta's 100th Anniversary in 2006. As you can see, there is still much to do but we will continue as long as financial support continues. For more on the specifics, read on...
