NEWS FROM THE HOUSE CORPORATION

This summer has been consumed with numerous renovation jobs in final preparation for the 100th. Dozens of volunteers participated in weekly work parties to haul, clean and repair. The House Corporation Board met in weekly teleconferences to cuss, discuss, plan and execute the numerous details of renovation and the 100th. The results will not disappoint.

Fire Sprinkler System. A commercial system was installed throughout the House at a cost of \$65,000 which included installing a new 4" water supply line from Gerald Avenue. The water line involved trenching and

repairs to the landscaping installed in Summer 2005. The landscape contractor promises to have it look green and gorgeous by Homecoming.

Paint-Interior. The 1st, 2nd and 3rd floors were professionally painted including the bedrooms and bathrooms. A number of the actives were hired to assist the painter. The Dining Room received a special paint plus something extra special from the actives.



New Doors. The 2nd floor hallway doors were all replaced with solid core oak doors.

Carpet. Selected areas of 1st floor plus all of 2nd and 3rd floors including bedrooms received new carpet.

New Draperies. Custom designed draperies hung in 1st floor formal rooms.

Wood Floors Refinished. Music Room, Library and Dining Room floors have been professionally refinished.

Stain Glass Repaired. All stain glass windows have been repaired and professionally cleaned.

Library Renovation. New lighting has been installed installed.

Sundeck. New terra cotta colored pavers have been added to enhance and protect the decking.

New Letters. New gold ΣΧ letters now grace the front of 1110 Gerald just above the front entry steps.

Backyard Wrought Iron Fence. A custom made wrought iron fence replaces the backyard gate.
